

Who Is ECCFPD

- 1924-2002 (Volunteer Organization)
- ECCFPD Established in 2002 (BOS)
- Governance: 2002-2010 (BOSP), 2010-2018 (Apo.), 2019 (Elected)
- Independent Special District
- Service Area- 249 Square Miles
- 2 Cities, Unincorporated East County
 - Approximately 132,400 residents (160,000 with workers)
- Annual Incidents: 8,481 10,606
 - Approximately 132,400 residents (160,000 with workers)
- Stations- 3 / 6 / 9-?

Historical Challenges

1) Serving our **EXISTING** population

- Currently, ECCFPD is not adequately funded to serve the EXISTING population in our service area.
- Currently, ECCFPD is funded at volunteer firefighting levels and trying to provide professional 24/7/365 services
- Currently have 3 stations Need 6 Stations (3 station deficit)

2) Preparing to serve projected future GROWTH

- ECCFPD needs stations 7-9 to address future growth over the next 20 years
- Don't repeat missed opportunities of the past.



What Has ECCFPD Done

2017-2022

- TRANSITIONED FROM A NON-SUSTAINABLE 4-5 STATION MODEL TO A SUSTAINABLE 3 STATION MODEL
- Resolved ECCFPD's retention issues
- IMPROVED PUBLIC PERSPECTIVE OF THE DISTRICT THROUGH CONSTANT PUBLIC OUTREACH THROUGH TRADITIONAL AND SOCIAL MEDIA CHANNELS
- Developed a 2019-2023 Strategic Plan
- Developed a succession plan for all District positions
- REPLACED ALL PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT AND ESTABLISHED AN EQUIPMENT REPLACEMENT PLAN
- Replaced all Type 1 (STRUCTURAL FIREFIGHTING) ENGINES
- REINFORCED ECCFPD'S ADMIN DIVISION AND DEVELOPED A HUMAN RESOURCES AND ACCOUNTING DIVISION
 AND HIRED NEW POSITIONS
- ESTABLISHED ECCFPD'S FIRST FIRE PREVENTION BUREAU AND DEVELOPED / HIRED NEW POSITIONS
- Constructed Station 55
- SOLD UNUSED AND SURPLUS PROPERTIES (57, 58, 95)
- Resolved the CCCERA Pension Challenges
- UPDATED THE IMPACT FEES IN OAKLEY, BRENTWOOD AND THE COUNTY




What Has ECCFPD Done

- CREATED THE DISTRICT-WIDE COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT
- Developed multiple benefit assessment revenue options for the Board to consider
- IDENTIFIED A PATH AND FUNDING FOR DEDICATED TRAINING GROUNDS WITHIN THE DISTRICT
- THE DISTRICT NOW HAS REPRESENTATION AT CALCHIEFS, FDAC, CSDA AND AT ALL COUNTY CHIEFS MEETINGS
- PREPARED AND BUDGETED TO STAFF FOURTH STATION (STATION 55) INDEPENDENT OF OR THROUGH
 CONSOLIDATION
- Defined a plan and timeline to staff a fifth station (Station 51) and sixth station (Station 54)
- OBTAINED THE DEEDS FOR STATIONS 52 AND 55, AND LAND FOR STATION 50/51
- ENGAGE AN ARCHITECT AND ENGINEER, BEGIN WORK ON THE DESIGN AND APPROVAL OF STATION 50/51
- COMPLETE FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR POTENTIAL CONSOLIDATION WITH CONTRA COSTA COUNTY FIRE
- Secured Measure X funds to address District's existing service level deficits
- COMPLETED A FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR THE IRONHOUSE FOR A DEDICATED TRAINING FACILITY

- Phase I (CON & CCE) 8/2020-12/2020 COMPLETED
- Phase II entire process: 12/2020- 7/2021- COMPLETED
- Phase II Update 4/14/2021 Board Meeting COMPLETED
- Phase II Findings Introduction- June (Finance Meeting) /2021 COMPLETED
- Phase II Conclusion (resolutions of intent approved to annex ECCFPD into CCCFPD)-COMPLETED
- Phase III LAFCO & SBE (entire process) 10/2021-4/2022- COMPLETED
- Phase IV Annexation implementation & ECCFPD / Board dissolved 6/30/200
 - Opening of Station 55 with Paramedic- ALS (Oakley): June 1, 2020
 - Station 52 (add Paramedic ALS)- July 1, 2022
